**DISCUSSION – ADULT AND CHILD DAYCARE CDBG PROJECT**

**Chief Planner Smyth reported that in 2005 the City had applied for \$1,500,000 3-year Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for establishing a child and adult daycare facility to be operated by Kings County Action Organization (KCAO) and Kings County Commission on Aging (KCCOA). The City was granted \$500,000; since the grant money received was significantly less than was needed for the project the City has had to look at other alternatives.**

**Ms. Smyth reviewed, via a slide presentation, the alternate sites reviewing the pros and cons of each site.**

**Cinnamon Municipal Complex  
SE Corner Cinnamon Drive and Fox Street  
G Street (Water-tank)  
SW Corner of Follet & G Streets  
Railroad Right-of-Way  
Magic Castle**

**The Magic Castle site appeared to be the best alternative at this time using the grant monies, program income, and RDA funds available.**

**Dave Droker of KCAO expressed support for the Magic Castle site as did Sharon DeMasters of KCCOA. Ms. DeMasters asked for assurances that the adult daycare would not be asked to vacate any site as the need for more space for child daycare arises.**

**REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION – ORDINANCE 2006-02 – AMENDING THE TIME LIMITS ON THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE LEMOORE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN:**

**Redevelopment Project Manager Narbaitz reported that in FY 03-04 cities that contributed the ERAF that year were eligible for the one year extension for the effectiveness of the Redevelopment Plan. Ordinance 2006-02 will extend the life of the Redevelopment Plan for the Plan Areas for one additional year.**

**It was moved by Councilmember Martin, seconded Councilmember Murray, and carried that the Council to waive the first reading of Ordinance No. 2006-02 and pass it to a second reading.**

**PRESENTATION – ANNUAL CRIME REPORT:**

**Police Chief Morrell presented the Annual Crime Report to the Council. Chief Morrell reported overall all calls for service were down 135 calls. Felony calls were up 137 calls and misdemeanor calls were up 100 calls. In the Seven Major Crimes Classification there were 0 homicide, 9 rapes, 9 robberies, 292 assaults, 513 larcenies, 100 auto thefts, and 146 burglaries. The Detective solved 92.9% of**

**the 536 cases assigned. There was a decrease in traffic accidents and citations. Animal Control had a 5.56% decrease in calls for service and Code Enforcement had a 7.63% increase in calls for service. Chief Morrell reported that the trends in Lemoore were similar to the trends in other cities in the area.**
