

**RESOLUTION NO. 2007 – 34**  
**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEMOORE**  
**IN SUPPORT OF CALIFORNIA ASSEMBLY BILL 783 (ARAMBULA)**

At a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Lemoore duly called and held on August 7 2007 at 7:30 p.m. on said day, it was moved by Councilmember \_\_\_\_\_, seconded by Councilmember \_\_\_\_\_, and carried that the following Resolution be adopted.

WHEREAS, The State Department of Public Health administers several sources of state funding for communities seeking to improve or expand their drinking water systems; and

WHEREAS, Drinking water grants and loans typically help to improve water delivery and to remove contaminants that may include microbes, such as giardia and fecal coliform; inorganic chemicals, such as nitrate and lead; and various organic compounds, such as the pesticide DBCP; and

WHEREAS, Supplying safe drinking water is often a major challenge in small, disadvantaged communities that typically do not have the cash or the debt capacity to finance major upgrades to their water systems, and that frequently lack the management resources, staff, and expertise to apply for outside funds that may be available to help them upgrade or repair their water systems; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 783 (Arambula) provides a statutory framework for the State Department of Public Health — regardless of the source of funding — to continue its focus on the needs of disadvantaged communities, and to better promote consolidation as a way of meeting those needs under certain circumstances.; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lemoore, while not directly benefiting from this legislation, recognizes from its own history and involvement with other Central Valley communities, such as Fowler, Mendota, San Joaquin, Huron, and Coalinga, the overwhelming need for disadvantaged communities to be extended such consideration as AB 783 provides;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Lemoore hereby goes on record supporting Assembly Bill 783, authored by California Assemblyman Juan Arambula, which would assist disadvantaged communities without adequate resources in providing safe drinking water to their residents.
