RESOLUTION NO. 2007-36

**A RESOLUTION OF THE LEMOORE CITY COUNCIL
DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO ABANDON LODGE WAY**

At a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Lemoore duly called and held on September 4, 2007 at 7:30 p.m. on said day, it was moved by Councilmember _____ seconded by Councilmember _____ and carried that the following Resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS, Lodge Way is a dead-end street in the Avalon Subdivision that was originally required to access the property to the south in the event of future development; and

WHEREAS, it has since been determined that the property to the south will not be developed and will continue its current use as a ponding basin; and

WHEREAS, the City has analyzed and examined the proposed abandonment and preliminarily finds that the proposed abandonment would not be detrimental to the public, health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lemoore desires to initiate abandonment proceeding under Chapter 3 of Division 9 of the Streets and Highway Code commencing with Section 8320 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the area proposed to be abandoned is shown on Exhibit “A” attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lemoore that:

1. The intent to vacate Lodge Way is hereby submitted to the Planning Commission to determine conformity with the Lemoore General Plan in accordance with Government Code Section 65402.
2. October 16, 2007, at 7:30 p.m. is hereby fixed as the time of public hearing before the City Council for all persons interested in the proposed vacation.
3. The City Clerk is directed to notify, in the manner prescribed by law, all affected persons of the proposed vacation and of the hearing thereon.
4. The City Clerk is directed to publish or post notice in the manner prescribed by law.
