

RESOLUTION NO.9927

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEMOORE
GRANTING CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO.9907
BY DANIEL AND LINDA BUMPUS**

At a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Lemoore duly called and held on October 19, 1999, at 7:30 p.m. on said day, it was moved by Councilmember Allvin, seconded by Councilmember Martin and carried that the following Resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS, Daniel and Linda Bumpus have submitted an application for Conditional Use Permit for performing personnel services including tattoo and body piercing at 214 Heinlen Street; and

WHEREAS, the subject building is located in a CC(Central Commercial) zone district; and

WHEREAS, the proposed tattoo and body piercing business is permitted in this zone district only as Conditional Use; and

WHEREAS, the Lemoore Planning Commission of the City of Lemoore conducted a public hearing on September 13, 1999, on the above stated Conditional Use Permit application and granted the permit subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission determined that this proposal does not involve any addition to the existing building and, therefore, is Categorically Exempted from California Environmental Quality Act as per Section 15301 of the State Guidelines, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Section 9-15B-2G of the Lemoore Municipal Code requires the City Council to review the Planning Commission's decision in its meeting held more than ten (10) days after the Planning Commission's decision on a Conditional Use Permit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Lemoore does hereby find that the applicants proposal is Categorically Exempted from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and does hereby affirm the Planning Commission's action to grant Conditional Use Permit No.9907 as applied for by Daniel and Linda Bumpus, with the following conditions:

1. That the use permit is for tattooing and body piercing business only and no other services are permitted.
2. That all required permits/approvals shall be obtained including the County Health Department approval and City's business license that may include background check.
3. That Conditional Use Permit shall expire in six (6) months from the date of its issuance and the business should start within this period.
4. That dimensioned drawings of any sign(s) to be placed on the building shall be submitted to the Community Development Department for approval.
5. That the exterior and window signs of the business will reflect the name of "Creative Designs" and will not include the words "tattoo" or "body-piercing".

6. That the applicant shall not do business (tattoo or piercing) with those who are under the influence of a prohibited substance, or intoxicated, or under 18 years of age without written proof and presence of a parent.
7. That no alcohol will be located or consumed on the premises.
8. That hours of operation to be from 1 p.m. to 10 p.m.
