RESOLUTION NO. 2008 –

**A RESOLUTION OF THE LEMOORE CITY COUNCIL
DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO ABANDON SARA DRIVE
(SPRING LANE WALKWAY FORMERLY IN THE LLMD – ZONE 4)**

At a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Lemoore duly called and held on March 18, 2008 at 7:30 p.m. on said day, it was moved by Council Member _____ seconded by Council Member _____ and carried that the following Resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS, Sara Drive / Spring Lane Walkway is a path way between Hanford-Armona Road, the Park Place Apartments and Spring Lane that was originally required to access the property as a safe route to school for the Lemoore Elementary School District's Meadow Lane School; and

WHEREAS, it has since been determined that the property is no longer needed with the addition of the new Cinnamon Elementary School south of Hanford-Armona Road; and

WHEREAS, the City has dissolved the Lighting Landscape Maintenance District – Zone 4 and the walkway has been walled up to the south end and is becoming a public safety hazard; and

WHEREAS, the City has analyzed and examined the proposed abandonment and preliminarily finds that the proposed abandonment would not be detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lemoore desires to initiate abandonment proceeding under Chapter 3 of Division 9 of the Streets and Highway Code commencing with Section 8320 et.seq.; and

WHEREAS, the area proposed to be abandoned is described and shown on Exhibit A & B attached.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lemoore that:

1. The intent to vacate Sara Drive / Running Springs Subdivision walkway is hereby submitted to the Planning Commission to determine conformity with the Lemoore General Plan in accordance with Government Code Section 65402.
2. May 6, 2008, at 7:30 p.m. is hereby fixed as the time of public hearing before the City Council for all persons interested in the proposed vacation.
3. The City Clerk is directed to notify, in the manner prescribed by law, all affected persons of the proposed vacation and of the hearing thereon..
4. The City Clerk is directed to publish or post notice in the manner prescribed by law.
