

Proclamation of the Mayor of the City of Lemoore

In Recognition of:

Motocyclers Awareness Month

May, 2008

Whereas, Motorcycle riding is a popular form of efficient transportation and recreation for more than 1,000,000 people in California; and

Whereas, It is important that the drivers of all vehicles be aware of one another and learn to share the road and practice courtesy; and,

Whereas, Motorcycles provide a means of transportation that cause less wear and tear on public roadways, and increases available parking areas; and,

Whereas, The safety hazards created by automobile operators who have not been educated to watch for motorcyclist on the streets and highways of California are of prime concern to motorcyclists; and,

Whereas, It is especially important that the citizens of California be aware of motorcycles on the streets and highways and recognize the importance of motorcycle safety; and,

Whereas, The American Brotherhood Aimed Toward Education (ABATE) of California, Local 57 Armona/Lemoore, is an organization that is actively promoting the safe operation, increased rider training, and increased motorist awareness of motorcycles; and

Whereas, It is important to recognize the need for awareness on the part of all driver, especially with regard to sharing the road with motorcycles, and to honor motorcyclists' many contributions to the communities in which they live and ride; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Lemoore recognizes the month of May 2008 as Motorcycle Awareness Month.
