

Dear City of Lemoore Water Customers:

The watering season is quickly coming upon us. With the warmer summer months approaching, the City of Lemoore Public Works wants to remind residents of the need for conservation.

As the demand for water increases the city water division will be adding more of its wells into the city system to meet these demands. With this increased pumping, it could change some of the characteristics of our water, such as taste, smell and color. The water quality is always a concern to city officials, and city staff will continue to work diligently to monitor the city water system to ensure water quality.

These conditions do not pose any health problems. The water supplied by the City of Lemoore is tested weekly and meets all State of California Health Service Regulations.

Water conservation is a concern for all of us. To encourage sound water conservation practices, the City of Lemoore water conservation ordinance contains the following requirements: **We will be enforcing these regulations.**

1. No outdoor watering on Mondays.
2. EVEN NUMBER ADDRESSES – you may water on: TUESDAY, THURSDAY, and SATURDAY.
3. ODD NUMBER ADDRESSES – you may water on: WEDNESDAY, FRIDAY, and SUNDAY.
4. Summer water toys may be used in place of sprinklers or hoses on scheduled watering days.
5. Washing of cars, boats or other vehicles for residential or fund raising purposes may be done on any day. Buckets and shut-off nozzles on hoses must be used when washing these vehicles in order to reduce water runoff.
6. A permit to drain a swimming pool must be obtained from the Lemoore Public Works Department before any work is done. There is no cost to obtain this permit.
7. The Water Ordinance applies to City-supplied water. Residents who are using their own wells for irrigation purposes are asked to contact Lemoore Public Works with that information, and to also conserve well water.
8. No person shall allow excessive water to run from their property onto streets or highways. Washing of exterior asphalt or concrete areas is prohibited except as provided for in Health Department or Fire Department regulations.

Your assistance in water conservation is greatly appreciated.
