

RESOLUTION NO. 9013

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEMOORE  
CREATING A TREE COMMITTEE, AND ESTABLISHING THE TERMS OF ITS  
MEMBERS AND PROVIDING FOR ITS DUTIES AND OFFICERS

At a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Lemoore duly called and held on March 6, 1990 at 7:30 p.m. on said day, it was moved by Councilmember Wyckoff, seconded by Councilmember Lyon, and carried that the following Resolution be adopted:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a Tree Committee is hereby established in the City of Lemoore.

1. Membership. The Lemoore Tree Committee shall consist of five (5) members appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council. In addition, a Councilmember designated by the Mayor for his or her term of office as Mayor and the City Manager, or his designee, shall be non-voting ex-officio members. Whenever, at the discretion of the City Council, the best interests of the City shall be served thereby, any members of the Committee may be removed from office by a majority vote of the Council.
2. Term of Office. Appointed members of the Committee shall serve without compensation for terms of four (4) years, and such terms may be extended at the pleasure of the City Council. Terms of the initial appointees shall commence on January 1st on the year following the date of appointment. Any vacancies that shall occur for any reason shall be filled by appointments to the unexpired terms.
3. Organization. Each year at its first meeting in January, the Committee shall elect a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman to hold office for the calendar year.
4. Meeting. The Tree Committee shall hold regular monthly meetings

on a date to be fixed by the Committee, and may hold such additional meetings as may be desired by the Committee. A regular Meeting may be cancelled by the Chairman if it is determined beforehand that a quorum will not be in attendance. Notice of such cancellation shall be given to the members prior to the date of the meeting.

5. Duties and Responsibilities. The Tree Committee shall act in an advisory capacity to the City Planning Commission and City Council, and shall forward all findings and recommendations to the Planning Commission and City Council, as appropriate. Primary responsibilities of the Committee shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
- A. To advise the Planning Commission in the preparation and maintenance of the City's Master List of Trees, Shrubs and Groundcovers and the Comprehensive Street Tree Plan.
  - B. To inventory and map the location, type, size and condition of existing street trees along the arterial street systems as described by the Lemoore General Plan, in accordance with priorities established by the Planning Commission and City Council.
  - C. To review official requests to the City for permits to remove trees within the rights-of-way of public streets and alleys, and to recommend appropriate action to the City Manager.
  - D. To review proposed actions by the Public Works Department to remove trees deemed to be a public nuisance.
  - E. To assist and voluntarily participate in the installation of trees on private property for the betterment of the quality of life for the residents of the City of Lemoore.
  - F. To undertake such related studies and recommendations as the City Council may direct.
