The purpose of the Lemoore Citizens' Academy is to provide citizens with a deeper understanding of how the Lemoore Police Department operates and to convey the Department's mission of community policing. The staff of the Lemoore Police Department believes that the success of crime prevention and detection lies in a strong partnership with members of the community they have sworn to serve. The Lemoore Citizens' Police Academy is designed to strengthen the relationship between the citizens and their Police Department. More can be accomplished to improve our community when citizens and police work together.

Because it is our wish that participants develop a sense of ownership in the Lemoore Police Department. Instructors of the Lemoore Citizens' Academy are members of the Lemoore Police Department with additional guest instructors from other governmental agencies.

The Lemoore Citizens' Police Academy is designed to give members of the community a better understanding of our overall criminal justice system. The Citizens' Academy will be tailored to the philosophy of community policing embraced by members of the Lemoore Police Department. Participants will receive classroom training on a variety of criminal justice topics, including crime prevention and Criminal Law. The Citizens' Police Academy is a seven week course with meetings scheduled one night per week (currently Wednesdays) for two to three hours. Additionally, each member of the Citizens' Academy class will be invited to participate in a ride-along program with a Lemoore Police Officer during the course of the academy. The academy will conclude with a graduation ceremony at which time Jeff Laws, Chief of Police will award each student completing the course with a diploma.
