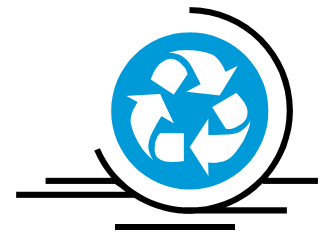




RECYCLING GUIDE

- Plate Glass and Mirrors
- Clothing
- Ceramic Dishes
- Dry, empty paint cans
- Coffee Grinds

- DO NOT INCLUDE**
- Hot coals or ashes
 - Paint
 - Liquid or hazardous waste

- Copy machines

- Cell phones
- Electronic Equipment
- Computers
- Mercury thermometers
- Monitors
- Cables and wires
- Printers

Place in E-Waste Dumpster inside first gate



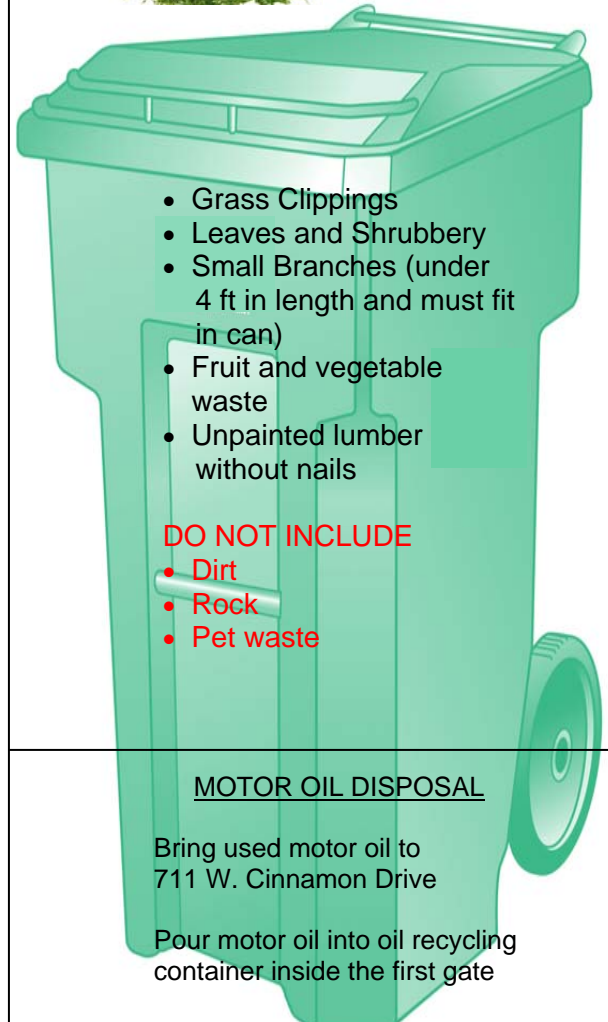
- Clean/Dry Paper**
- Newspaper
 - Cardboard
 - Junk mail
 - White paper
 - Magazines and catalogs
 - Phone books
 - Egg cartons
 - Paper bags
 - Waxy milk cartons

- Plastic: Recycle Symbols 1-7**
- Styrofoam (cups, plates)
 - Empty containers from butter, margarine, cottage cheese, and yogurt
 - Plastic grocery bags
 - Empty milk jugs
 - Empty soda and water bottles
 - Empty detergent and shampoo bottles

- Tin Cans**
- Empty aerosol cans
 - Empty food cans

Glass Bottles and Jars

Aluminum Cans
Clean Aluminum Foil



- Grass Clippings
- Leaves and Shrubbery
- Small Branches (under 4 ft in length and must fit in can)
- Fruit and vegetable waste
- Unpainted lumber without nails

- DO NOT INCLUDE**
- Dirt
 - Rock
 - Pet waste
